THE great majority of the illustrations in this book are printed from photographs taken by Lady Aberdeen's Kodak; but in some instances use has been made of photographs collected by Lord and Lady Aberdeen when travelling. As these were, however, mostly unmounted, the name of the photographer does not always appear, so that acknowledgment of their origin cannot in every case be recorded. But special mention must be made of Messrs Notman of Montreal, and Messrs Boorne and May of Calgary, whose well known work will be recognised in some of the illustrations inserted.

If in some cases there is an unavoidable omission of acknowledgment, an apology is hereby offered, any such omission being quite unintentional.
