spectacular and sacerdotal worship. The letter killeth, the spirit giveth life!

(5) The responsibility of becoming less Sectarian and more Catholic as evangelical denominations. In the South African campaign, Australian and Canadian regiments unite with the Imperial troops under Gen. Methuen, in the advance to the relief of Kimberley. In our greater campaign against the principalities and powers of darkness, what name we are known by as a division of Christ's army is a minor matter. The grand aim is the relief of the perishing, and the defence of the truth as it it in Christ Jesus.

Let us, therefore, resolve to preach Christ and Him crucified with more fervor and unction than at any time in our past. Let us abide hard by that immovable Rock—the vicarious sacrifice of the God-Man.

Thus only can our own souls be enlarged and our influence extend. Thus only can our ministers have power in sifting error, in deepening spiritual life, in checking the ravages, delusions and anti-Christian movements of the hour, and above all, in helping a return all along our military ranks towards the sir plicity of Jesus. Therefore, let "Back to Christ" be the watchword of each Protestant pulpit in our land.
