The lady was silent. "Nay, Miss," said he, "say what you will, the gospel is the power of God unto salvation."—*Christian Secretary*.

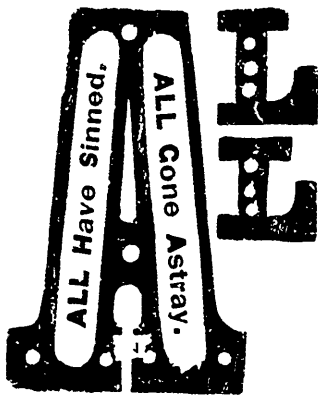
