

- **DO** install your system on a solid work surface that will not vibrate or shake from accidental bumps.
- **DO** park the heads and turn the machine off before lifting it to retrieve an item that has rolled under it.
- In essence, treat your system as you would an expensive stereo system with a delicate turntable.
- And finally, MFB - Make Frequent Backups.

2.3.4 Reformats/Deletions and Recovery

If you accidentally delete files from, or re-format a diskette or hard disk, **DO NOT PERFORM ANY OTHER OPERATION ON THAT DISK.** Call the Microcentre immediately; someone there may be able to recover the data with specialized utility software.

2.4 Tempest And The Teamug

The term TEMPEST refers to a set of standards, originally developed by the U.S. military, for the protection of equipment from electronic eavesdropping.

Any and ALL computer processing of CLASSIFIED information must be done on a Tempest-compliant machine.

Form EXT 1241 should be affixed to non-Tempest equipment, and form EXT 1242 to Tempest equipment.

If your machine has neither form, assume that it is NON-Tempest.
