York University Administrative Studies

This is a direct exchange program integrated in the framework of the Baden-Württemberg⁻ Ontario exchange agreement. This direct agreement between the Universität Mannheim and the University of York allows for up to eight students from either university to study at the partner university for one year.

Applicants are expected to have a B.A. or the "Vordiplom" respectively and should have third year standing when leaving for Canada. German students should have reached 580 points in the TOEFL Test.

Applicants are screened and selected by a committee of representatives from the "Akademisches Auslandsamt" and the departments in Mannheim and a similar committee in York.

The agreement includes a tuition waiver and German participants may apply for a supportive grant for travel expenses from the Land of Baden-Württemberg.

Students remain enrolled at their home university for the time of the exchange.

Graduate students can do an MBA degree provided that they reach at least 580 points in the TOEFL-Test and 550 points in the GMAT, but as there is no tuition waiver for this part of the exchange program, participants will have to pay about CDN \$ 8000 themselves.

This specified bilateral program between the Universität Mannheim and York University has been extended recently and more universities from other regions joined this particular agreement (e.g. Wales, Catalunya or Regione Lombardia - Multiregional International Business Program/MIBP).
