Dear Sir Arthur:

At a meeting of the Special Library Committee held yesterday afternoon a thorough inspection of the building was made and the enclosed memorandum of proposed changes was approved. I was directed to communicate this to you and to ask for your authority to take up the matter immediately with the architect designated by you.

It is to be noted that the proposed re-arrangement of the rooms in the present building will provide a much needed periodical room, a students' room, and seminar rooms, and that these changes will not involve any expensive remodelling.
