

may then form a local committee for taking such action in regard to the admission of new members and any other matter they may think necessary, so long as such action does not conflict with the Constitution and By-laws of the Institute.

UNSUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS.

5. Unsuccessful applicants shall not be eligible for admission until the expiration of six months from the date of rejection.

BALLOT.

6. All candidates for admission as members shall be ballotted for ; and five black balls shall exclude.

- FEES.

7. For members, resident in Toronto and its vicinity, first year ten dollars for entrance fee and yearly subscription ; and subsequently a yearly subscription of five dollars. For members not resident in Toronto, six dollars for entrance and yearly subscription, and subsequently a yearly subscription of three dollars.

8. All entrance fees shall be payable on admission, and all annual subscriptions in advance on the first day of January in each year. Members joining after the first day of July shall receive a rebate of half the annual subscription.

MEMBERS IN ARREARS.

9. No member shall be eligible for office or be entitled to vote, who is in arrears for fees, or dues of any kind.

LAPSE OF MEMBERSHIP.

10. Any member shall cease to be such, if he allow his subscriptions, fees, or dues of any kind, to fall in arrear of payment for the period of twelve months from date of maturity, after being notified and his attention called to this By-law.

PENALTIES.

11. Any member against whom charges shall be brought, shall be tried before the Council, and on proof shall be liable to suspension or expulsion.
