An Act respecting the Northwest Commercial Travellers' Association of Canada.

WHEREAS, by chapter 50 of the statutes of 1887 of the pro-Preamble. vince of Manitoba, The Northwest Commercial Travellers' Association of Canada, hereinafter called "the Association," was Manitoba incorporated for the purposes and with the powers in the said 1887, c. 50. 5 statute mentioned; and whereas a petition has been presented by the Association praying that it be granted express authority to carry on throughout Canada its business as authorized by the said statute, and also praying that certain amendments to the said statute be made: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the 10 advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, declares and enacts as follows:—

1. The Northwest Commercial Travellers' Association of Provincial Canada is hereby recognised as a corporation with all the rights, corporation powers and privileges of a corporation incorporated by the laws a Dominion 15 of Canada, and is hereby authorized and empowered to carry on corporation, and transact its business throughout Canada as if the Association empowered had been incorporated for its corporate purposes under the laws to do business of Canada, and is hereby declared to have the capacity to carry throughout on its said business in and throughout Canada; provided that

the said capacity hereby granted to the Association shall be Proviso as to exercised, in the several provinces and Territories of Canada in application of which the Association may carry on its business, subject to all and the general laws of the said provinces or territories applicable to general laws. the Association.

2.
