But, behold, Ld O_d had scarce resigned his last Breath before he began to revere the Ashes of that very Man whose Destruction he had before labored to effect, half bullying, half yielding to the thenreigning Administration, whom he was courting at the same time that he was maltreating, till, in short, Mr. P-m and he could agree upon Terms, which were no fooner fettled than he was forced on his late Majesty, by a Measure which was not effected without offering the highest Indignity to the Throne, and fuch as almost partook of Treason itself: From which Time all Opposition, on his Part, to Hanoverians and Hanoverian Meafures, totally ceased, against whom and against which no Man had inveighed with greater Bitterness and Inveteracy than himself.
