

WASHINGTON, Sept. 20.—The House late today passed the war revenue bill, designed to raise by taxation approximately \$8,188,000,000 of the \$24,000,000,000 or more needed by the nation for the current year. A formal roil-call, demanded by Majority Leader Kitchin, recorded 350 yeas and no nays. The announcement by Speaker Clark was greeted by a roar of cheers and applause.

Mr. Merner, another witness, also stated that the doctor told him that he could make no charge, but that he would willingly do the operation for him. The case was dismissed by the magistrate, with the statement that Dr. Metcalfe should be commended for his work rather than prosecuted or persecuted.


