

A British Government to Remain in Office, Opinion of Critics.

London, Feb. 1.—W. L. A. Burdett-Coutts, M.P., speaking at the Westminster Conservative Club tonight, said:

The government would remain in office until the Russo-Japanese war was concluded, and predicted the ending of that conflict during the coming summer.

He said the Anglo-Japanese alliance was the most precious act of foreign policy ever achieved by Great Britain, and Premier Balfour was bound by every consideration of honor and patriotism to remain in office during the critical period, when the war being conducted in the east, has not and perhaps not ever will stop in and perhaps rob Japan before.

With the closing of the war, the speaker said, would come a period of fine diplomacy, and it was impossible to see how the powers might stop in and perhaps rob Japan before.


