FORM OF A BEQUEST TO THE METHODIST MISSIONARY SOCIETY.

I GIVE and bequeath to the Missionary Society of the Methodist Church of Canada, the sum of \$ (or Real Estate—describing same,) to be paid, expended, and applied by said Society in the aid and support of the Missionaries upon the different Mission Stations of said Society, and the receipt or receipts of such Treasurer or Treasurers for the time being shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executors. And the published Journals of the General Conference of the Methodist Church of Canada shall be a sufficient evidence of authority for the said Treasurer or Treasurers upon which to demand and receive payment of said bequest.

N.B.—Devises for such purposes as the above must be made at least six months before the death of the person making the same, to make valid any devise of land or any interest in land.

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
