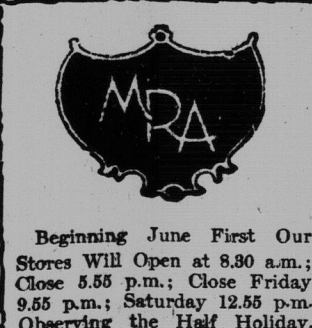

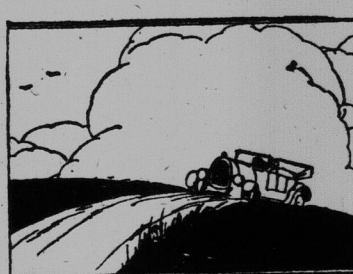

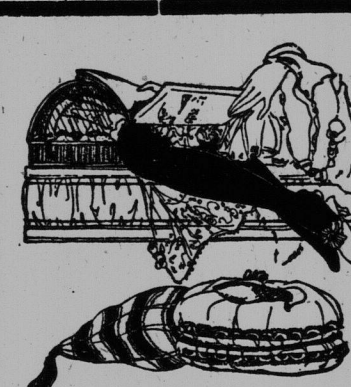

GYRO CLUB
FORMED HERE

A local chapter of the international association of gyro clubs was provisionally formed here yesterday afternoon in the office of W. Grant Smith, who was elected president pro tem. A similar organization has been recently established in Halifax. The membership is limited to those of thirty-five or under. It was agreed to have forty members in the new club. It is planned to have periodic luncheon meetings for discussion of civic and commercial affairs.
The other provisional officers chosen at yesterday's meeting were: Vice-president, H. Vincent; secretary, P. B. Cross; treasurer, D. W. Armstrong. G. S. Dearborn was chosen chairman of the provisional membership committee, the other members of which are W. R. Walsh, H. S. Gregory and H. D. Wetmore. C. H. Dearborn was named chairman of a constitutional committee. He will select the other members of that committee which will report back to a subsequent meeting.

Plans for the formal opening of the Red Cross recreation hut for the Lancaster Hospital were discussed yesterday. It was decided to postpone the formal opening from next week to June 11 or 12. It is hoped that Hon. Dr. Beland, the federal minister of health will be present. It was also decided to ask clergymen of the city who has served overseas to take part. It is hoped that a brass band will volunteer. The matter of furnishing was also taken up. The building is about completed, at a cost of nearly \$7,000.
