LOCAL NEWS

Mayor Hayes spent some time yesterday afternoon affixing his name to the block of something more than 1000 is just being issued to cover work done.

Hon. John Williams, 19 Hanover street, has received a telegram from the Canadian Red Cross containing the good news that her husband, Private John Williams, 8th C. M. R., who has been a prisoner in Germany for more than two years, has arrived in England.

There was a very large attendance at the "Tuxis boys" convalescence in the Y. M. C. A. building last evening and the programme was an exceptionally fine one. The ladies of Exmouth street church served the supper which opened the proceedings at 6:30 o'clock and Dr. Farris of the County Hospital who was the speaker of the evening gave a splendid address on the subject of health which was entitled "What kind of a house do

you live in?" Rev. R. Taylor McKim presided at the meeting which closed with the usual course of Bible study and gymnasium exercises.

The regular meeting of the Diocesan board of the Women's Auxiliary met in Trinity church school room, yesterday afternoon, and had the opportunity of listening to a very fine address by Mr. Earb from India on the conditions of women in that land. The president, Mrs. Thomas Walker was in the chair and the meeting was opened by Rev. Canon Armstrong. The treasurer read letters of appeal which had been received with regard to the endowment fund for missions to Indians and Eskimoes in Canada. Until recently these races have been reached by missions endowed in England, but that endowment is no longer forthcoming and the W. A. in Canada has been asked to raise \$25,000 for this purpose, \$1,600 being the appropriation for the diocese of Fredericton. The corresponding secretary, Mrs. W. D. Foster read a letter from the Dominion secretary with regard to the resolutions adopted at the Triennial convention held in Winnipeg in October. The usual reports were read and

were very satisfactory. Letters of sympathy were sent to the Dalhousie branch and to the Bay Du Vin branch, each of which had suffered the loss of their president. Mrs. Barrette was the Dalhousie president and Mrs. Williston the Bay Du Vin president. Arrangements were made for the packing of the Christmas boxes which are sent each year to the country districts in the province. The packing will commence next week in the Church of England Institute.

Among the St. John officers to return recently from the front was Lieutenant Fred J. Newcombe. Lieutenant Newcombe went overseas in the 140th Battalion with the rank of captain, but desiring to get to France he reverted and was successful in getting with an eastern Ontario battalion. He was more than a year in France when he was taken with trench fever and was invalided home. He is well known in St. John and there will be many who will be glad to hear of his safe return from overseas. Lieutenant Newcombe is a brother-in-law of Captain G. Earle Logan, deputy judge advocate-general for M. D. No. 7. Both officers went to France from England in the same regiment and fought together for several months. Lieutenant Newcombe was formerly a mail clerk.

The monthly meeting of the local board of health was held yesterday afternoon. Senator Daniel acted as chairman. Reports of the month were received and approved. There was an extended session as the board has just concluded a period of great activity owing to the recent influenza epidemic. The business transacted, however, was mostly of a routine nature.
