SEEKS CASH TO WIN PORTUGAL THRONE

Dom Miguel Hoped Daughter-in-Law, Formerly Anita Stewart, Would Aid - Seeks Some Financier

(Special Cable to the New York Times and Montreal Gazette.) Paris, March 28.—The financial agents of the royalist pretender to the Portuguese throne, Dom Miguel de Braganza, are searching Europe for a wealthy man who will lend \$1,500,000 for the purpose of financing a revolution in Portugal next autumn.

Dom Miguel's agents say that he is now the accepted candidate to the throne of Portugal on account of the abdication of King Manuel at a family meeting in Vienna on the occasion of the christening of the eldest son of the Archduke Carl Ferdinand. The Manuelists, however, deny this story of abdication.

Although Dom Miguel has a patrimony of a few million francs and receives a pension from the Hapsburgs, he does not intend to waste his own money on the revolution.

His agents, however, talk optimistically of his chances. They say that 40,000 rifles, with the requisite ammunition, are already concealed in the northern provinces of Portugal, waiting for the favorable moment for a coup.

They add that three torpedo boats have been ordered from well-known builders on the Tyne, but admit that the money to pay for them is lacking and that the firm refuses to continue their construction and make delivery until they receive further amounts on account.

Therefore the agents of Braganza are beseeching financiers and banks to advance them the money on the securities of phantom possessions in the future.

Dom Miguel had hoped that his daughter-in-law (nee Stewart) would lend some of her millions, but the Duchess de Vizeu, who is well aware that when her husband married her he renounced all possible claims to succession in favour of her own, has refused to lend him a cent.

The Miguelist plans of campaign always supposing that the money can be found, base their hopes of success on the reports received in Maximilian Strasse, Vienna, that Portugal is heartily weary of the republic and that in the autumn

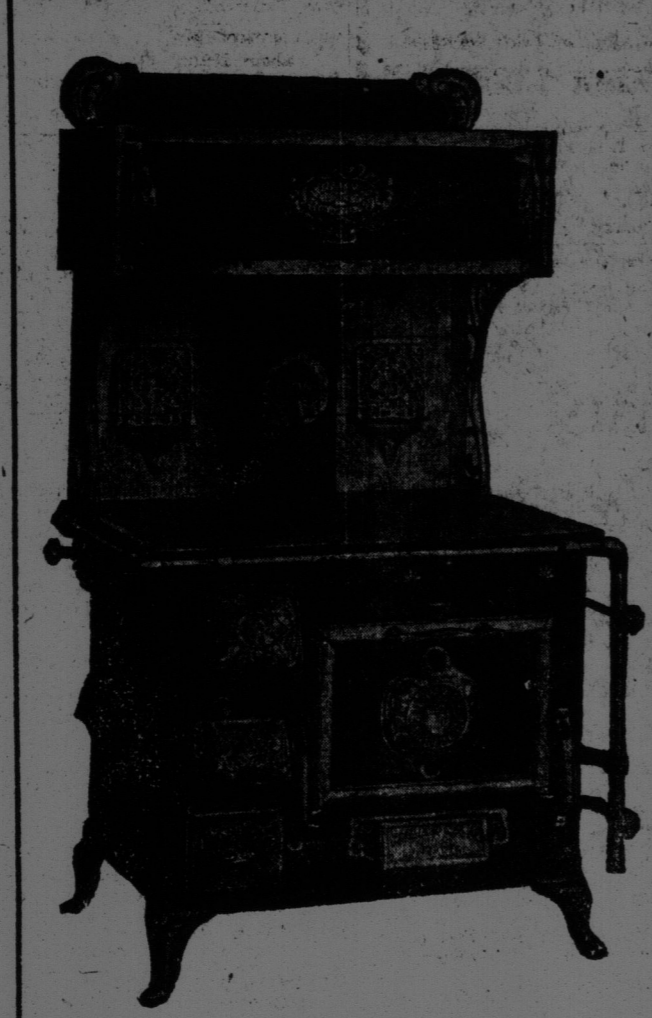

GAMBLING HAS GRIP ON WOMEN OF LONDON

Vice Said to Be on Increase; Even School Girls Drawn Into Toils

In an article headed "Cards That Lure Women," The London Daily Mirror draws attention to the prevalence of gambling in England. The vice, among women especially, is believed to be on the increase.

How many British homes, asks the Daily Mirror, are ruined every year through the curse of the gambling habit?

The paper goes on to say: "If we could arrive at even approximate figures the answer would be startling. And today the curse is most deeply centred in women. The old pictures by Frith, of the gambler's road to ruin are hopelessly out of date today. It is not always now the man who gambles away house and home on the turn of a pack of cards.

"Half the gambling dens in the West End of London are kept in their present flourishing condition owing to the patronage of women, while the habit of afternoon 'play' has become one of the pests of the social world. Card tea parties are a fashion that serve the dual purpose of being source of income and ruin.

"Chemin de fer' is the game which it is declared, is most popular with women gamblers. In a recent case a woman of good social position was alleged to have lost a large sum of money at this game.

Inquiries made among those who have an inside knowledge of some of these secret gambling "dens," show that the number of women who frequent them is increasing to an alarming extent. In many cases, chemin de fer has taken the place of bridge, and gambling parties are held nightly at some of the largest and most respectable-looking houses in Belgrave and Mayfair.

Occasionally mere school girls are drawn into the gamblers' toils, often pawning their jewelry and their dearest possessions to pay off gambling debts.

An ingenious plan for guarding against police raids has been devised by some wealthy gamblers, including several women. The game—usually chemin de fer—is never held in the same house on two consecutive nights. A meeting place is decided upon late in the afternoon, and telegrams are sent to the players.
