Sacred Music Given at Trinity Church Last Evening—Service Attended by a Large Congregation.



**Border Towns And Exchange Rates**

Effect on Business Conditions at St. Stephen and Milltown Not Great—Calais Not Losing Population.

"Of course the exchange rate has some influence on affairs at the border, but I don't know that it is causing anybody any serious worry," remarked a gentleman from Milltown who was in the city yesterday.  
"More Americans who are working in the New Brunswick factories are dealing with St. Stephen or Milltown merchants than usual, and there has been some transfers of banking accounts. But stories which have been sent out that Calais had been hard hit are rather exaggerated. I have not observed any movement of families from Calais to the New Brunswick side worth speaking about, though possibly there might be if houses were available.  
"In any case there is no striking evidence that the merchants of Calais are being put out of business, or the American banks on the border having a hard time. While the New Brunswick industries provide a certain amount of employment for people in


