

It is the custom of Japanese merchants to place on the market, let us say, a brand of home-made Scotch whisky in bottless bearing a label almost exactly similar to those used by a well known distilling firm with an established reputation. The Japanese label will differ from the label on the Scotch firm in some inconsequential particulars, discernible only through close comparison.
