

Graduates of Horton Collegiate Academy, of the St. Martin's Seminary, and of approved High Schools may be admitted without examination, upon presentation of certificates that they have completed the prescribed studies and passed satisfactory examinations thereon.

The holder of a certificate or license required of teachers of the first class in any of the Provinces of Canada will be exempted from examination in English, History, Geography and Mathematics.

Students desiring to enter upon the full Course or to take general studies should report themselves to the President for registration on the day before the opening of the College. A fee of one dollar is charged for registration, and an additional fee of one dollar for matriculation.

Applicants for admission must be sixteen years of age and must present a certificate of good moral character.
