DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENTS

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Mark MacGuigan, announces the following appointments:

Marius J. Bujold (43) originally from Caplan, Quebec, to be Ambassador to Senegal, with concurrent accreditation to the Gambia, Cape Verde, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau and Mauritania.

Mr. Bujold (B.A. (Pol.), University of Montreal; M.A., Laval University; MPA, ENAP/Quebec) joined the Department of External Affairs in 1965. He has served abroad in Tunis, Lagos, Paris (OECD) and Dakar. Since 1979 he has been Director of Francophone Affairs Division at headquarters. Mr. Bujold will replace Mr. Marc Perron who is returning to Ottawa.

Clayton G. Bullis (50) originally from Kingston, Ontario, to be Ambassador to Chile.

Mr. Bullis (B.A., Queen's University; M. Comm., University of Toronto) joined the Trade Commissioner Service in 1958.
