# VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

## C A P . I .

An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain sums of money required for defraying certain expenses of the Civil Government and other purposes, for the year 1863, for making good certain sums expended for the public service in 1862, and for raising a Loan on the Credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

[Assented to 15th October, 1863.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN :

**W**HEREAS it appears by Messages from His Excellency the Right Honorable Charles Stanley Viscount Monck, Governor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over this Province of Canada, and the Estimates accompanying the same, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Civil Government of this Province and of the Public Service thereof, and other purposes, for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and to make good certain sums expended for the Public Service, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two :—May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, that—

1. From and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province, there shall and may be paid, and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole three millions, nine hundred and nine thousand, four hundred and fifty-four dollars, and twenty-seven cents, for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of this Province for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and not otherwise, provided for,
