1. Bill further to amend and to consolidate, as so amended, the several Acts respecting the Public Lands of the Dominion therein mentioned (Sir John A. Macdonald); Ordered; Presented, 72. Read second time, 197. Motion for House in Committee; Debate thereon interrupted by Private Bills, 271. Resumed, 272. Motion agreed to; House in Committee; Progress reported, 273, 283. House again in Committee; Bill amended; Considered; Motion for third reading; Amendment moved by Mr. Charlton to recommit Bill, so as to provide that all sales of Agricultural Lands shall be made on condition of actual settlement by the purchaser, &c.; Debate thereon interrupted by Private Bills, 291. Resumed; Motion for adjournment of House; Withdrawn; Amendment negatived, 293. Bill read third time and passed, 294. By the Senate, with amendments, 365.
