An Act to afford relief to Trustees, Executors, and Administrators.

ER Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. Trustees, Executors, and Administrators, may charge and recover for Payment. their services in like manner as Agents in ordinary cases.

II. They may resign their respective offices as herein mentioned.

Resignation.

5 III. Before resigning they shall publish a notice of such their intention Notice before in some Provincial Newspaper, where the estate or cestui que trust or resigning. party resigning resides, or as near thereto as convenient, for two calendar months; after which a resignation shall be filed, in the case of Trustees in Chancery, and in the case of Excutors or Administrators in the Court from 10 which Letters Probate or of Administration issued.

IV. They shall be liable to account, as in ordinary cases.

V. The Court in which the resignation is filed shall appoint another or Appointment others in the place of those resigning.
