An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Mount Royal Cemetery Company.

TATHEREAS the Trustees of The Mount Royal Cemetery Preamble. Company have petitioned for an extension of their powers, and it is expedient to grant the prayer thereof: Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

5 That the said Company shall have full power and authority to Company may designate and establish, take, appropriate, have and hold the requitable land adjoining the site land adjoining the site of the Cemetery, adapted and required Cemetery, or required to afford easy ingress and egress to and from the said Cemetery, from the City of ingress and 10 Montreal and from the Côte des Neiges road, according to the also, take maprovisions hereinafter contained for acquiring the same; and to dig, terials for roads, &c. take, and carry away stone, gravel, sand, earth, and other like materials from any adjoining or neighbouring lands, and also to cut, make and keep in repair upon such adjoining or neighbouring lands, 15 such ditches, drains, and water courses as may be necessary for the effectual draining and carrying off the water from the said Cemetery. and the roads leading thereto; and for the purposes aforesaid, the said Company and their agents, servants and workmen, are hereby authorized and empowered to enter into and upon the lands and 20 ground of any person or persons, body or bodies corporate or politic.

II. And be it enacted. That if the owner or owners, occupier or Arbitration if occupiers of any lands which the said Company may be desirous of the Company acquiring for the purposes aforesaid, or from which materials are to owning the be taken, shall, upon demand made by the Trustees of the said land, &c. cannot agree. 25 Company, neglect or refuse to agree upon the price or amount of damages to be paid for such land, and appropriating the same to the use of the said Company, or for the exercise of any such powers as aforesaid, it shall and may be lawful for the said Company to name one arbitrator, and for the owner or occupier of such land so required. 30 or with regard to which such power is intended to be exercised as aforesaid, to name another arbitrator, and for the said two arbitrators
