to a Member who has made a substantive motion to the House, but not to any Member who has moved an order of the day, an amendment, the previous question, or an instruction to a committee.---B. 417. M. 359.

III .- CONDUCT OF MEMBERS.

16. No Member is entitled to vote upon personally any question in which he has a direct pecuniary interest, and the vote of any Member so interested will be disallowed -B 455. M. 490.

> 17. When the Speaker is putting a question, no Member shall walk out of or across the House, or make any noise or disturbance; and when a Member is speaking, no Member shall interrupt him, except to order, nor pass between him and the chair; and no Member may pass between the chair and the table, nor between the chair and the mace when the mace has been taken off the table by the Serieant.-B. 405. 406. 421. M. 385.

Attendance of Members.

18. Every Member is bound to attend the service of the House, unless leave of absence has been given him by the House. -B. 190, 501. M. 228, 233.
