Provided always, and be it enacted, To what pur-5 That the rents, revenues, issues and profits poses the revenue of the of all property real or personal held by the Corporation said Corporation shall be appropriated and plied. applied solely to the maintainance of the members of the Corporation, the construc-10 tion and repair of the buildings requisite for the purposes of the said Corporation, and to the advancement of education, and the payment of the expenses to be incurred for objects legitimately connected with or 15 depending on the purposes aforesaid.

III. And be it enacted, That all and Property of every the estate and property real and per-the present sonal belonging to or hereafter to be acquired vested in the by the members of the said Association and its By-20 as such, and all debts, claims and rights laws made whatsoever due to them in that quality shall those of the be and are hereby vested in the Corporation until altered hereby established; and the rules, orders and regulations now made or to be made for 25 the management of the said Association, shall be and continue to be the rules, orders and regulations of the said Corporation until altered or repealed in the manner herein provided.

30 IV. And be it enacted, That the members corporation of the said Corporation for the time being may appoint Attorneys. or a majority of them, shall have power to Officers, &c. appoint such Attorney or Attorneys, Administrator or Administrators of the property 35 of the Corporation, and such officers and teachers and servants of the said Corporation as shall be necessary for the well conducting of the business and affairs thereof, and to allow to them such compensation for their 40 services respectively as shall be reasonable and proper; and all officers so appointed shall be capable of exercising such other , powers and authority for the well governing
