BILL.

An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Montreal Asylum for Aged and Infirm Women.

WHEREAS the Ladies, Directresses, and Members of the Corporation Presuble. of the Montreal Asylum for Aged and Infirm Women, incorporated by an Act passed in the 4th and 5th years of Her Majesty's reign, and chaptered 67, have by their petition prayed for a change in 5 the name of the said Corporation, and for certain amendments to the said Act of Incorporation, and it is but just to accede to their prayer; Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. The said Corporation of the Montreal Asylum for Aged and Infirm Women shall hereafter be known and designated as Les Sœurs de 10, l'Asile de la Providence de Montreal, and shall enjoy all the advantages conferred upon the said Corporation by the said Act passed in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's reign, chaptered sixty-seven as hereby amended.

Name of the Corporation changed.

II. The second section of the said Act is repealed, and a majority of 15 the members of the said Corporation is hereby authorised to make all necessary By-laws relating to the admission of members of the said Corporation, the manner of calling meetings of the members of the said Corporation, the period at which such meetings shall be held, the number of members requisite to constitute a quorum at such meetings, and 20 generally all other By-laws necessary for the administration of the property and affairs of the said Corporation, and to amend and repeal them from time to time in whole or in part, provided that the said By-laws are not contrary to this Act, nor to the laws in force in this Province.

Sec. 2 of 435, V: c. 67 amended. Any majority of the members of the Corporation may make

By-laws.

III. The said Corporation may appoint such officers, agents or admi-25 nistrators as may be necessary for the efficient management of the property and affairs of the said Corporation.

Corporation may appoint Agents.

IV. This Act shall be deemed to be a public Act.
