

Grant to the Crown by the Chipewyan Indians

Description of the first Grant 22 October 1796. Consideration Money \$1200 Quebec Currency in Gov. ad. a Tract of Land situated on the north side of the River Thames. Beginning on a certain Station on the North Bank of the said River about Ninety Miles above the Delaware Village, following the windings of the said River and about Twelve miles distant from the said Village in a direct northerly course being about Two miles above a Lime Stone Rock and Spring on the said River which Station will be more perfectly found by a line run from the main or lower fork of London Six Miles and a course South Sixty eight degrees Thirty Minutes West by the Magnet thence North Twenty one degrees Thirty Minutes West until it intersects the said River Thames which said intersection or Station or place of beginning from thence North Twenty one degrees Thirty Minutes West Twelve Miles then North Sixty eight degrees Thirty Minutes East Twelve Miles then South Twenty one degrees Thirty Minutes East until it intersects a red line remaining from the upper fork of the said River at Oxford to the main or lower fork of the said River at London thence along the said line to the said upper fork on a course North Sixty eight degrees Thirty Minutes East thence down the said River Thames following the several windings and courses with the stream to the place of beginning.

Island of St. Joseph's purchased from the Indians on the 20th day of July 1798.

Sanawick Reserve purchased from the Indians for the Consideration of \$300 Quebec Currency in Gov. ad. Called the Huron Church Reserve 3 day of January 1801. Beginning at a Stone Boundary Between the Land of Thomas McKee and the said Huron Church Reserve from thence following the windings of the said River to a certain Creek about One hundred and fifty seven yards above a Mudmire belonging or lately belonging to M^{rs} Babij thence South Seventy degrees East forty three Chains & Sixty four links thence South Twenty eight degrees East One hundred and Thirty four Chains and Two links and thence North Seventy four degrees West One hundred and Sixty one Chains & Forty links until it intersects the said River Detroit which intersection is the Station or place of beginning. and also an additional space
