In reference to your letter of the 7th. of July last regarding renewal of your timber license No. 180 I have to state that complaints have been received that a considerable quantity of the timber reported cut last season, was taken from trees of less size than 10 inches at the stump. Your culler returns appear to corroborate this, especially with respect to the hardwood timber. Further our agent reports, after making an examination of the woods that under size second growth timber had been cut and a number of logs were left lying in the bush where they had been cut.
