confined to Russia, though Russia is its place of origin, but a danger which menaces first of all Central Europe and then nations protected, no doubt, by their geographical position from immediate danger, but which, directly and indirectly, are equally predestined to suffer if nothing is done to stop the plague. That is all I have to say on the subject of Russia.
