Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th inst., with which you forwarded a communication from the wife of Mr. Ross who desires to accompany her husband, who is to be a member of your party on the trip to Oxford House, God's Lake, and Island Lake, and in reply I beg to say with reference to her request to be allowed to take the journey, that the Government has no objection to her going with the party, provided her presence will not occasion any additional expense or be the cause of inconvenience. It is assumed that an extra canoe will be required if she joins the party.
