I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 27th ultime, in further reference to the payments made to the Church of England Boarding School at Hay River during the year 1902, and in reply I beg to say that in view of your statements as to the difficulty of obtaining supplementary returns to account for the shortage made in that year, the Department has forwarded a cheque covering the balance of the grant to the Rev. Dean Griswold, Winnipeg.


As this payment is irregular the supplementary returns will be required as soon as they can be conveniently obtained. The following statement shows how this balance is made up.;
