In view of the report contained in the letter of the 13th inst., I beg to say that you should not furnish relief to Mrs. Eliza Williams, but, if at a later date, you find that the woman is unable to work and consider her in destitute circumstances, you should report her case to the Department, making at the same time a recommendation with regard to the amount of assistance which you consider she should receive.
