Sir,"

I beg to draw your attention to the fact that the Department requires from you this year, as in the past, information with regard to crops sown, etc. You should bear the fact in mind when preparing your report for the month of May, and when writing out your reports for June and July you should show approximately the area of new land broken, etc. These instructions should be carefully observed.

At the end of the season the Department will expect a return showing the crops (grain and roots) sown and harvested; also the quantity of hay put up and the area of new land broken and summer fallowed, disced and fall ploughed; also the work done by individual Indians on each reserve with regard to the breaking of land, etc. In this connection I have to refer to circular letter of the 1913; 13th October, the provisions of which should be observed.
