THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL:

WHEREAS the Minister of National War Services and the Acting Minister of Labour report that there is a growing scercity of men available for service in His Majesty's armed forces and for employment in the war industries and that it is necessary for the effective prosecution of the war to take steps to restrict the entry of men who are of military age and physically fit for service with the armed forces into certain occupations which are relatively unessential or can be satisfactorily filled by women or men who are beyond military age or are physically unfit for service with the armed forces;

General in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister of National War Services and the Acting Minister of Labour and under the authority of the War Measures Act, Chapter 206 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, 1927, and The Hational Resources Mobilization Act, 1940, Chapter 13 of the Statutes of Canada, 1940, is pleased to make and doth hereby make the following order:

- ORDER -

- 1. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires -
 - (a) "Administrative Division" means an administrative territorial division established under the National War Services Regulations, 1940 (Recruits);
 - (b) "Applicant" means any person who has applied to a Mational Selective Service Officer for permission to enter into employment in a restricted occupation.
 - (e) "Director of Mational Selective Service" means the person appointed as such by the Governor in Council.
