1. One P.C.O., and two O.R.'s will be detailed for duties as Stewards for marginally noted.
2. The P.C.O. will be responsible to respective committee, namely, Officer's Mess and Men's Canteen committees for the efficient operation of those institutes insofar as the following is concerned.

- (a) Cleanliness of Canteens and ante rooms.
- (b) Arrange for rotation leaves for his staff.
- (c) To observe regulations as laid down for canteen Steward's instructions.

3. O.R.'s employed in canteen or bar will come under the supervision of the P.C.O. in charge.

4. One member of the Canteen Staff and Officer's Mess Bar must be on duty at all times, One Steward only to be on leave at any one time.

5. Personnel on duty will sleep in respective buildings where employed.

6. For purpose of discipline, duties and leave, all staff employed on Regimental institutes will come under the supervision of the President of the composite Canteen.
