PAST SERVICE BENEFITS FOR MARRIED WOMEN

The Directors reviewed the progress report which detailed a plan of study by Management in order to recognize service of married women prior to the establishment of the Pension Plan.

THAT Management prepare for the September Directors' meeting recommendations regarding past service benefits for married women. CARRIED.

ENGINEERING

The V/P, Engineering reviewed the various sections of this report and explained the system used with respect to the calling of tenders for CBC construction projects.

PLANNING

The V/P, Planning reviewed the proposed coverage policy and pro forma (Part I of the Planning Report) to be used in considering future extensions of service. It was emphasized that the population figures currently used in this coverage planning submission were based on current DBS data which would be subject to change in the light of 1966 census information expected to be available at the end of this year. In reviewing the six population categories in the pro forma (page 2), it was suggested that Management should consider reducing the first four categories to two: viz, mother tongue English and mother tongue French, and retaining the final two categories, viz, bilinguals whose mother tongue is neither English nor French and people who speak neither English nor French.

Dr. Raynauld moved, seconded by Dr. Beveridge

THAT the coverage policy and pro forma to provide for extension of radio and television service to unserved communities in Canada, attached as Appendix III, be approved.

CARRIED.

The tentative schedule of TV applications for future BBG meetings as contained in Part II of the Planning report was reviewed.

Management was requested to recalculate projects in this schedule between June 1966 and April 1967 based on the new coverage policy and forward to Directors for their information. Recalling that the Board had approved those projects scheduled for hearing by BBG up to September 1966, it was suggested that the applications to be heard by the BBG in November 1966 and January 1967 be recalculated for presentation at the September Directors' meeting.
