tituled "An Act for regulating, laying out and repairing Highways " and Roads, and for appointing Commissioners and Surveyors of "Highways within the leveral Towns and Parishes in this Province," be further continued and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force for the term of Two years, and until the end of the Continued for Two years, then next Session of the General Assembly.

CAP. VIII.

An Act in amendment of an Act, intituled "An Act co to repeal all the Acts now in force relating to "Trespasses and for making new regulations to " prevent the same." Passed the 7th of March, 1814.

WHEREAS doubts have arisen with respect to the power of the Preamble.

Justices in their General Session of the Peace for the Counties of York and Charlette, to make fulficient regulations for the preventing Trespasses by Horses and Swine in the Parish of Fredericton and Town of Saint Andrews in the laid Counties-

Be it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That from and after the paffing of this Act, if any Horle, Horles or Swine, shall Theovernofany Horles be found going at large within that part of the Parish of Fredericton large in that part of the fituate between Phillis's Creek and the Creek or Gully to the South-Parish of Fredericton beward of the late Dr. Earl's dwelling house in the County of York, or the Creek to the Southin the Town Platt of Saint Andrews in the County of Charlotte, ward of Dr. Early dwelthe owner or owners thereof shall forfeit and pay the sum of ten shilling boult; or in the saint so so for each and every Horse or Swine so found going at large, one drews, to so feeling shill half to the Overseers of the Poor of the said Parishes respectively, and lings for each Horse or one half to the Informer, to be recovered upon conviction before Swines. any one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, residing in the said Parishes respectively, and to be levied of the goods and chattels of the owner or owners of fuch Horle, Horles or Swine. And in case If the owner thall not be the owner or owners of fuch Horfe, Horfes or Swine shall not be known the Hogreeve shall be the duty of the Horfes or Unarrange of impound the Horfes or known, then it shall be the duty of the Hogreeve or Hogreeves of Swine. the faid Parithes to impound such Horse, Horses or Swine, as shall be found fo going at large. And it shall be the duty of the Pound keepers of the And the Pound keeper faid Parishes of Fredericton and Saint Andrews respectively, upon any on the door of the Pound. Horse, Horses or Swine being so impounded, to advertize the same upon the door of the Pound, and in case the owner or owners of It the owner shall not fuch Horse, Horses or Swine, shall not within Three days after such fine, advertizement being put up as aforefaid, pay the faid fine for each Horse or Swine so impounded, together with the accustomed sees and charges for keeping the same, it shall and may be lawful for the said the Pound keeper shall Pound keepers to sell such Horse, Horses or Swine at Public Auction, and apand apply the money arising therefrom towards paying the said fine ply the money to pay the and charges, and pay the overplus (if any) to the owner or owners the overplus (if any) to she owner or owners the overplus (if any) to of such Horse, Horses or Swine, whenever such owner or owners shall the owner when he apappear.
