An Act for Compiling and Printing a New Edition of the Laws of the Colony of British Columbia.

[28th March, 1871.

WHEREAS it is expedient that measures should be adopted for Preamble. Compiling a New Edition of the Laws of the Colony of British Columbia, and for Printing the same, and for omitting in the republication of such Edition all such Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations, and parts of Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations as have expired, been repealed, or had their effect;

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Columbia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-

I. It shall be lawful for the Governor to issue a Commission, Authorizing the apunder the Great Seal, to three persons, constituting them Commissioners of Comsioners for compiling and printing a new edition of the Laws of the missioners to comscioners of British Columbia, and from time to time, in case of the death, or refusal, or incapacity to act of any or either of the said Commissioners, to appoint some other person or persons to be a Commissioner or Commissioners, as aforesaid, to accomplish the purposes of this Act.

II. The said Commissioners shall be and they are hereby fully Commissioners to authorized and empowered to prepare and arrange for publication the said new edition of the Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations in force in the Colony of British Columbia, or any part thereof, at the time of the compilation thereof,—to omit all such Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations, and parts of Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations which have expired, been repealed, or had their effect, and all Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations repealing any or any parts of any Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations, and parts of Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations, and parts of Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations, and parts of Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations, and Proclamations of Acts, Ordinances, and Proclamations, and Proclamations.
