and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the Fourteenth Year of His Majesty's reign, entitled "An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province" and by the authority of the same, that out of the fund or funds subject to the disposition of the Parliament of this Province now remaining in the hands of the Receiver General unappropriated, there shall be issued and applied, the sum of Two Thousand and Sixteen pounds nine shillings and four pence to make good the said sum which has been issued and advanced in pursuance of the aforesaid address.

11 - And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the due application of the said Sum of Money, pursuant to the direction of this Act, shall be accounted for to His Majesty, His Lieirs, and Successors, through How paid and acthe Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury for the time being, in counted for. such manner and form as His Majesty, His Heirs, and Successors, may be graciously pleased to direct.

## CHAP. IV.

AN ACT to authorise the Justices of the Home District to raise a further Sum by Loan, to be applied in completing a Gaol and Court House for the said District.

[Passed 13th April, 1825]

HEREAS, it appears by the Petition of the Justices of the Peace for the Home District, in Adjourned Quarter Sessions Assembled, that in order to complete the Gaol and Court House for that District, it would be necessary to raise by Loan a further Sum in addition to that which the Justices are now authorised to borrow: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Viost Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, and Assembly, of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and Assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled " An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act Passed in the Fourteenth Year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act for making more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America; and to make further Provision for the Government of the said Province," And by the authority of the same, that it shall and may be lawful for the Justices of the Peace in and for the Home District, in General Quarter Sessions Assembled, in the Month of May next, or at any subsequent General Quarter Sessions or Adjourned Session, by Justices an order of Court, to authorise and direct the Treasurer of the said District Peace for the Home to raise by Loan, from such Person or Persons, Bodies Politic, or Corporate, the Treasurer to who may be willing to lend the same on the credit of the District, a Sum not loan £2000 to be exceeding Two Thousand Pounds, to be applied in the same manner as the Monies authorised to be borrowed by an Act of the Parliament of this and Court House.
