

Results for the half year ended Tune 30, however, because of the substantial gains recorded in March and April are well ahead of the best previous figures in the history

best previous figures in the history of the country. At \$123,324,424 for the six months, the aggregate stands \$3.635,350 ahead of the high record established in the corresponding period of 1917. It compares with less than \$75,000,000 in the depressed six months ending June 30, 1915, the increase over that period therefore amounting to more than \$48,0000,000 or about 64 per cent.
