Pittman's horse on this particular trip to the wharf became frightened for some reason just as it was going under the tramway and in his effort to control the animal the unfortunate man either forgot to lower his head or the plunge of the cart threw him up from his seat for the top of his head struck against the beam above and he collapsed on his load of laths The driver of the cart immediately behind and others in the .vicinity
