The Church and War.

The conference gave open expression as to their stand on the great question of world peace by passing the following resolution:-

With deepened gratitude and reverent silence we stand before the memorials of our glorious dead who bravely fought in the Great War to preserve our heritage of freedom; but we are firmly convinced that war is not a normal function of any society and that the glorifying of war should And whereas, the Golden Rule grants no exceptions to nations and is as binding upon governments and groups of people as upon individuals, and whereas the recognition of war as a legal method of settling disputes is a survival of barbarism, a travesty of justice, a negation of morality and religion and a menace to the progress and existence of Christian civilization, therefore, be it resolved that this conference denounce the outlawry of war as a method of settling international disputes) and pledge ourselves to do all within our power to advance the principles
