TWO ARE ONLY WOUNDED

Out of Six, One Escapes, But is Will Remain a Short Time Pursued-Citizens Demand Better Protection.

[Canadian Press.] New Hazelton, B. C., April 7 .- Two of

six masked bandits were killed at 10:30 today in a battle between the robbers and a big posse of citizens following the holdup of the Union Bank of Canada. Two others were captured and three were injured. The robbers secured \$1,100 in cash. The bank, which is a substantial building of log construction standing by itself apart from other business houses, had opened for business only a few minutes this morning when the robbery was pulled off. Two men armed with rifles walked up the road, two others appeared in the bush at the rear of the bank, while Janeiro very soor the last two came from another direc-

The first two jumped inside the door of the bank and, with rifles raised called out. "Hands up!"

The other four appeared almost at the same instant, taking up positions out side the bank.

John Gaslin, manager of Lynch Bros., a contracting firm. Gaslin had a stack of currency and postal orders in his hands and less than \$50 in cash.

Arrangements have been completed whereby these fairs will be held in Nisscuri, including fifteen schools; in Melbourne, including eighteen schools, and in Wardsville with five school. These fairs are organized and run by

pupils of the various schools under supervision of the Middlesex Branch of the Department of Agriculture, their purpose being to stimulate an interest in the various phases of agricultural work among the pupils of the public schools. The seed for the competitions is sup
