
TORONTO, July 2.—Receipts of live stock at the City Market, as reported by the railways, were 67 carloads, composed of 886 cattle, 1279 hogs, 1033 sheep, 181 calves and 25 horses.

No straight loads of export cattle were on bale. A few steers picked out of loads of butchers, sold at \$6 to \$8.25; export bulls, \$4.25 to \$8.25 per cwt.


