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## INCORPORATION IN THE KOOTENAY LANGUAGE. By Dr. A. F. CHAMBERLAIN, Clark University, Worcester, Mass.

INCORPORATION and allied morphological phenomena are essential characteristics of American aboriginal tongues, and the consideration of these in the Kootenay of British Columbia, — one of the most recent linguistic stocks to be scientifically investigated, — is of interest to all Americanists and students of language. The Kootenay presents examples of the following varieties.
