(2) Paying patients in public wards, \$2.80 per week.

(3) Semi-private and private wards, from \$5 : \$15 per week.

Hours for Visitors.

Public wards, 3—5 and 7—8 p.m., Tuesdays, Fridays and Sundays; private and semi-private wards, 3—5 and 7—8 p.m. any day.

Any regularly qualified medical practitioner may attend

paying patients.

City order patients attended by members of the hospital staff only.

Objects.

This institution is intended for the benefit of convalescents leaving hospitals, or living in houses where their recovery is retarded by the want of needed rest and change.

It is managed by a committee of thirty ladies, elected

annually.

Anyone desiring to obtain a city order for a patient must send to the City Health Officer: (1) A medical certificate from a doctor in attendance stating that the applicant is a fit subject for admission to the Home; (2) a recommendation showing that the applicant cannot pay the ordinary charges.

Infectious or contagious cases cannot be admitted to the

Home.

Unmarried women with infants cannot be admitted, nor any man or woman known to be leading an immoral life.

A few private rooms provided at from \$4 to \$9 per week;

public rooms, \$2.80 per week, in advance.

Patients may be visited by their friends on Thursdays between the hours of 2 and 5 p.m., and on any evening, Sundays excepted, from 7 to 8 p.m.
