A TABLESPOONPUL of strong coffee put in the gravy of melted butter, pepper, and salt to be poured over beefsteak imparts a delicious flavour to gravy and meat. It makes the gravy a rich brown.

For a face powder finely sifted oatmeal is good, while some recommend crushed starch, but the objection to this is, if it is not the roughly smooth and fine, it scratches and irritates the complexion.

CHILDREN should not wear corsets too early. A stiff plain bodice is quite sufficient, on to which the skirts may be fastened. We should consider twelve years of age quite soon enough to commence.

WEIGHING GROCERIES.—It ought to be the practice of housekeepers to imitate the frugal Chinamen, who, on setting up housekeeping buys, first of all, scales for weighing his domestic supplies. The habit is to despise small economies and trust the tradesman. An ounce off your beefsteak is six per cent, profit per pound to the butcher, and the same is true of groceries and vegetables.

ORANGE BISCUIL.—Beat unt.: quite light the volk of six eggs with five ounces of white sub\_at: add one sour orange, grated, and four ounces of sifted flour. When these are well mixed, stir in the whites of six eggs beaten to a froth. Have ready a dozen small teacups, prepared first by buttering and then sifting in a little flour and blowing out what does not adhere. Divide the mixture into these cups, soft sugar on top and bake to a handsome brown.

GREASE STAINS IN SILK.—A sure and safe way to remove grease stains from silks, is to rub the spot quickly with brown paper; the friction will soon draw out the grease; or, lay the silk upon a table with an ironing-blanket under it, the right side of the silk downwards; put a piece of brown paper on the top, and apply a flat-iron just hot enough to scorch the paper. I have found this receipt more efficacious than any scouring drops ever compounded. ever compounded.

CORN-MEAL FRITTERS.—Two cups of white corn-meal, three cups of sweet milk, one-half cup of flour, four eggs, beaten separately, a tablespoonful of melted butter, a tespoonful of sait, two teaspoonfuls of baking powder. Beat the yolks, to them add the milk, butter, salt and meal, beat hird, add next the whipped whites, and last the flour and baking powder. Drop at once into boiling lard. Eat with a hard or liquor sauce. The batter should be just thick enough to drop readily from the spoon. Make the fritters of small size. Very nice as a side dish to be eaten with meat.

Dried Foods.—At present we export to Europe, about 6,000,000 pounds of evaporated apples. The process is extremely simple. The fruit is "cored" and sliced into pieces, one-sixteenth of an inch in thickness; it is then exposed to sulphur fumes, which arrest all fermentation; and then to a dry and hot blast fair, which reduces it to about halfits original weight. The sulphur fumigation prevents the fruit from becoming dark, and, after drying, it is almost as white as when first cut. Simple as is this process, it costs about twice as much as drying the fruit in the sun, but such is the saving in weight and fivour, that it is preferred, and evaporated apples sell to-day, in the European markets, for fifteen cents a pound.




