PRAYERS.

Mr. Hazen, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House,—List of Shipping issued by the Department of Marine and Fisheries, being a List of Vessels on the Registry Books of the Dominion of Canada, on the 31st December, 1916. (*Sessional Papers, No. 22.*)

Sir Robert Borden, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid on the Table,—Copy of Order in Council, P.C. 2245, dated 3rd September, 1917, appointing the Deputy Minister of Justice, Oliver Mowat Biggar, of the City of Edmonton, John H. Moss, of the City of Toronto, Louis Loranger, of the City of Montreal, and Lt.-Col. H. A. C. Machin, of the Town of Kenora, Ont., a council to advise and assist in the administration and enforcement of the Military Service Act, 1917, to be known as the Military Service Council.
