## Question No. 1,466-Mr. Forrestall:

With respect to the establishment of STOL type air service between Ottawa and Montreal, is it the intention of the Department of Transport to permit privately owned aircraft with STOL capability to operate in and out of both facilities?

Mr. Gérard Duquet (Parliamentary Secretary to Minister of Transport): 1. The Department of Transport is actively engaged in work which will lead to the detailed definition of the characteristics of STOL air transport systems including the design criteria of STOL-ports. This work is directed towards optimising the STOL system. The operating criteria and regulations applicable to aircraft using the STOLports will emerge from this work when it is completed late in 1972.

The Seaway International Bridge Corporation, Ltd., a subsidiary of The St. Lawrence Seaway Authority advises as follows: Yes. For vehicular transits on the Seaway International Bridge which crosses the St. Lawrence River between Cornwall, Ontario, and Massena, New York.

The National Harbours Board advises as follows: The National Harbours Board operates toll facilities on Champlain Bridge.

Purpose: For vehicular transits on the Champlain Bridge.
