Rissa tridactyla pollicaris. PACIFIC KITTIWAKE.

This is the form of the Kittiwake that occurs on the west coast of Vancouver Island (*Fannin*), and north to Bering's Sea.

GLAUCOUS GULL.

The older authors called this bird the "Burgomaster." It is an Arctic species, but a few examples are found in winter along the Atlantic coast of the Maritime Provinces, and in the Great Lakes. It is found, also, in winter, on the west coast of Vancouver Island.

Larus leucopterus.

ICELAND GULL.

This was formerly known as the "White-winged" Gull. It is an Arctic species, and is found, in winter only, along the Atlantic coast of the Maritime Provinces, straying occasionally to the Great Lakes.

Larus glaucescens.

GLAUCOUS-WINGED GULL.

A Pacific species that occurs along the coast from "Alaska south to California." Mr. FANNIN has observed it only on the north-west shore of Vancouver, but Dr. DAWSON took it at Cullen Harbour, Queen Charlotte Sound (*Whiteaves*).

Larus kumlieni.

KUMLIEN'S GULL.

A few examples of this lately described Gull have been taken in the Bay of Fundy in winter. KUMLIEN found it breeding in Cumberland Bay, where it is quite common. La
